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A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BOARD OF

PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF LEWES AMENDING ITS

COMPILATION OF POLICIES REGARDING ESTABLISHING A

STANDARDIZED PROCESS FOR ADOPTING POLICIES

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 WHEREAS, Section 4.1, among other provisions, of the Charter for the Board of Public Works of the City of Lewes (the "Lewes BPW"), being Chapter 10, Volume 77, <u>Laws of Delaware</u>, as amended (the "Lewes BPW Charter"), grants the Lewes BPW authority, responsibility, supervision, and control over current or future utility systems established within the Lewes BPW Service Area;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Lewes BPW (the "Board") adopted a Compilation of Policies on June 29, 2022 concerning various aspects of Lewes BPW authority, responsibility, supervision, and control over its utility systems, including electric, water, sewer, and stormwater rates, pension plans, financial services, impact fees, and other rules and regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board deems it in the best interest of the ratepayers to update its Compilation of Policies concerning establishing a standardized process for adopting Lewes BPW policies.

**Section 1.** The Board of Public Works of the City of Lewes: Policies is hereby amended by adding a new Section 7, titled Policy Procedures, with additions shown by bold/underline as follows:

## 7 Policy Procedures

## 7.1 Purpose

The purpose of this Section is to standardize the procedures and methods through which the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the Board of Public Works of the City of Lewes (the "BPW") will exercise its policy making powers as a chartered utility board of the State of Delaware.

## 7.2 **Definitions**

(1) "Board" shall mean the Board of Directors of the Board of Public Works of the City of Lewes as established pursuant to the Board of Public Works Charter (the "Charter").

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3. Should the Board approve the Policy proposal for public comment, a copy of the full text of said Policy proposal along with a brief synopsis of the subject of said Policy proposal, will be posted in the "Policies / Resolutions" page on the BPW's website (https://www.lewesbpwde.gov/information/resolutions/). The BPW will also post a copy at the Lewes Board of Public Works Office ("BPW Office") located at 107 Franklin Avenue, Lewes, Delaware.

- 4. The posted copy of the Policy proposal will provide the manner through which persons may present their views in writing, including the place to which and the final date by which such views may be submitted. The final date for public comment will be at least fifteen (15) calendar days after approval by the Board for public comment and publication on the BPW's website.
- 5. Following this public comment period, the Board may consider the Policy proposal during a future Board meeting. The Board may reject, approve, or revise the Policy proposal. Should the Board choose to revise the Policy proposal, the Board in its discretion may, but is not obligated to, republish the as-revised Policy proposal for further public comment before taking action.
- 6. Following adoption of any Policy proposal pursuant to this procedure, the BPW compilation of policies (i.e., the Board of Public Works of the City of Lewes Policies) will be updated to incorporate said Policy and notice of the adoption of said Policy will be published on the BPW website and in a paper of general circulation within the City of Lewes.

## 7.4 Emergency Policies and Other Exemptions to Procedure for Adopting Policies

- 1. All Policies will be adopted according to these procedures unless the Board, in its sole discretion, determines that good cause exists to bypass the public comment period and incorporates this finding and a brief statement of reasons therefor in the Policy proposal.
- 2. Examples of good cause appropriate to bypass the public comment period include, but are not limited to:
  - a. Nonsubstantive changes in existing resolutions or policies to alter style or form or to correct technical errors;
  - b. Amendments to existing resolutions or policies to make them consistent with changes in basic law but which do not otherwise alter the substance of those resolutions or policies;
  - c. When notice and the public procedure thereon are impracticable, unnecessary, or contrary to the public interest.
  - d. If the Board determines that an imminent peril to the public health, safety, or welfare requires the adoption, amendment or repeal of a policy with less than the notice provided in these procedures.
